1/ **Officer of the Day:** Call our secure answering service several times on the day that you are scheduled to work. Talk with clients/social workers on your telephone line about their specific aid requests and make follow-up phone calls about each case. Home or cell-phone based. 100% secure - volunteer phone numbers always remain private.

2/ **Driver:** Use your own vehicle to drive clients to medical appointments and/or deliver food bags to needy families.
